HE WAS THE COMMISSIONER OF MN CORRECTIONS FROM 1979 TO 1982, APPOINTED BY GOV. AL QUIE.

HIS CAREER STARTED AS A PROBATION OFFICER IN ST. LOUIS COUNTY AND ROSE TO COURT SERVICE DIRECTOR THERE. WILL TURNBLADH AND HOWARD COSTELLO GOT HIM TO BE THE SUPERINTENDANT AT ST CLOUD REFORMATORY FROM \$163 TO 1968 WHEN COMM. PAUL KEVE MOVED HIM TO BE WARDEN AT STILLWATER PRISON. HE BECAME AN EXECUTIVE FOR THE WILDER FOUNDATION COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PROGRAMS AND FROM 1982 TO 1989 HE WAS DIRECTOR OF RAMSEY COUNTY CORRECTIONS.

MN CORRECTIONS ASSN. GAVE HIM THE 'EXCELLENCE IN CORRECTIONS' AWARD IN 1989.



TOM STARTED HIS CAREER AT STILLWATER PRISON 9-14-59 AND LATER BECAME A FIELD AGENT UNDER MORRIE HEILIG. PROMOTED TO FIELD SUPERVISOR OVER METRO AGENTS IN 1966. HE TOOK AN EDUCATION LEAVE TO OBTAIN HIS MSW FROM THE U OF MISSOURI. HE RETURNED UNDER HAROLD HANSEN IN COMMUNITY SERVICES AND THEN BECAME ASSOCIATE WARDEN AT MCF STILLWATER - LATER MOVING TO OAK PARK HTS PRISON AND BECOMING THE 'CORRECTIONAL FACILITY DIRECTOR' THERE, WHERE HE RETIRED IN 1998. TOM PASSED AWAY, SUDDENLY, AUGUST 12TH, 2014. HE WAS 78.

THE 'MN HOME SCHOOL FOR GIRLS' WAS CLOSED A FEW YEARS AGO. A DULUTH PERSON HOPED TO DEVELOP IT AS A 'PRIVATE' CORRECTIONS INSTITUTION. APPARENTLY, THAT DIDN'T WORK AND IT STOOD EMPTY FOR AWHILE.

BUT NOW, IT HAS BEEN TURNED INTO A RESIDENTIAL HOUSING FACILITY FOR VETERANS SUFFERING FROM THE EMOTIONAL WOUNDS OF WAR AND NEED A PLACE TO STAY UNTIL THEY CAN REINTEGRATE BACK INTO SOCIETY.

THE LONG PRAIRIE NEWSPAPER, THE "LEADER', REPORTS THERE ARE 40 VETS RESIDING THERE.

REPORT FROM 'DR' JERRY O'ROURKE JERRY, FORMER SUPT. AT THE RED WING CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, SAYS, HE DID FINISH HIS LIFE LONG PURSUIT OF A PHD. "JUVENILE JUSTICE 1955-2005'.

HE SAYS HIS WIFE, KAREN AND HE COMPLETED THEIR 'BUCKET LIST' OF SETTING FOOT ON ALL SEVEN CONTINENTS.

RETIRED PAROLE/PROBATION AGENT SAM KNUTSON, ST CLOUD, ANNOUNCED HE AND HIS WIFE WERE GOING TO TAKE A 'NORWAY TRIP'.

'ARIZONA REPUBLIC' NEWS REPORTED
"2-hour execution took 15 attempts"

IN A HEADLINE OF AUG. 2ND.
THE ARIZONA REPUBLIC STATED THAT
CONVICTED KILLER, JOSEPH WOOD WAS
SENTENCED TO BE EXECUTED ON JULY 23 BY
LETHAL INJECTION.

HE DID DIE BUT THE NEWSPAPER REPORTS IT TOOK 15 INJECTIONS OF THE LETHAL DRUGS OVER A 2 HOUR PERIOD TO ACCOMPLISH IT.

ARIZONA CORRECTIONS DIRECTOR CHARLES RYAN ASSERTED THE EXECUTION WAS NOT BOTCHED BUT THE MATTER IS UNDER REVIEW.

THESE EXECUTIONS TAKE PLACE AT THE STATE PRISON AT FLORENCE AZ.

ANOTHER ARTICLE IN THE NEWSPAPER RECOUNTED THE HISTORY OF EXECUTIONS IN ARIZONA:

SINCE IT STARTED IN 1910 100 PEOPLE WERE KILLED IN DIFFERENT FASHIONS. THE STATE USED TO HANG MURDERERS. MOST OF THE 100 DIED IN GAS CHAMBERS, 35 BY LETHAL INJECTION AND 28 HANGED.

THE PAPER SAYS A WOMAN IN 1930 WAS HANGED FOR MURDER AND THE ROPE CAUSED HER TO BE DECAPITATED! IT CAUSED ARIZONA TO SWITCH TO A GAS CHAMBER.

THE PAPER SAYS 32 STATES HAVE THE DEATH PENALTY AND 18 STATES ABOLISHED IT. MINNESOTA WASN'T MENTIONED.

(THANKS TO MY ARIZONA REPORTER FOR ALL THE INFO).

EDITOR'S COMMENT - HAVING KNOWN MANY OF MINNESOTA'S WARDENS - I FIND IT HARD TO BELIEVE ANY WOULD BE INVOLVED IN ADMINISTERING THE 'DEATH PENALTY".

FROM THE 'BILLINGS GAZETTE"AFTER RETIRING FROM TOP PRISON JOBS IN
MINNESOTA, DENNIS BENSON AND JESSICA
SYMMES BENSON CHOSE TO MOVE TO
BILLINGS AND BUY A CASINO.
THE COUPLE RENAMED 'COLBY'S CASINO' ...
IN HONOR OF THEIR PARALLEL CAREERS
IN CORRECTIONS, CALLING IT "THE WARDEN'S
CASINO"

THEY FILLED ONE CORNER WITH PRISON ARTIFACTS SUCH AS OLD LEG IRONS, PRISON LOCKS AND KEYS.

STARTING OUT AS A CLERK TYPIST AT THE STATE PRISON IN STILLWATER MINN. IN THE 1970'S, THE 5 FOOT TALL JESSICA ADVANCED TO THE TOP JOB OF MINNESOTA'S MAXIMUM SECURITY PRISON, OAK PARK HTS.

DENNIS BENSON WAS A WARDEN AT NEARBY STILLWATER STATE PRISON AND RETIRED AS THE NO. 2 GUY AT THE MN DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS.

THEY PURCHASED THE BILLINGS CASINO FROM BENSON'S COLLEGE ROOMMATE AND FRIEND, JOHN HERNANDEZ. THE MEXICAN IMMIGRANT BECAME AN AMERICAN CITIZEN AND EVENTUALLY SAVED ENOUGH MONEY IN 1999 TO BUY THE 'STATELINE RESTAURANT BAR & CASINO' LOCATED A FEW FEET INTO MONTANA JUST WEST OF WILLISTON, N.D. BEFORE THE BAKKEN OIL BOOM HIT, DENNIS BENSON SAID. "NOW IT IS THE HIGHEST-GROSSING CASINO IN MONTANA", HE SAID.

OIL FIELD WORKERS ARE KEEPING THE 'STATELINE' SO BUSY THAT HERNANDEZ' SON, COLBY, BUILT AN ADJOINING CASINO, CALLED 'COLBY'S' THAT SHOULD OPEN JUNE 1st.

A LOVE OF MONTANA BROUGHT THE BENSON'S WEST, AND BUYING A CASINO IN FEBRUARY PROVED TO BE A WISE CHOICE, AT LEAST WEATHER-WISE.

"WHEN WE GOT OUT HERE, THERE WAS NO SNOW AND MINNESOTA HAS HAD FOUR OR FIVE MORE SNOWSTORMS" HE SAID.

THE WARDEN'S CASINO IS SPECIAL BECAUSE IT IS COMFORTABLE" HE SAID.

"PEOPLE HAVE ROOM, IT'S CLEAN AND NICELY DECORATED." BENSON SAID. IT'S A DECENT PLACE, NOT A ROWDY BAR."

NATURALLY, THE BENSON'S CHOSE THREE PADLOCKS FOR THEIR WINNING LINES ON THE SLOT MACHINES. "THAT'S GOING TO BE OUR SHTICK: TWO RETIRED PRISON WARDENS," HE SAID."

HE STARTED AS A C.O. AT OPH IN 1983
AND TRANSFERRED TO MCF FARIBAULT WHEN

MCF SHAKOPEE WHERE HE RECENTLY
RETIRED FROM (7-23-14)

MANKATO FREE PRESS REPORTS COMMUNICATION PROBLEMS BETWEEN DOC AND CITY OF MANKATO
